In September 2019, the German research icebreaker RV POLARSTERN has set sail from Tromsø, Norway, to spend a year drifting through the Arctic Ocean - trapped in ice. The goal of the expedition is to investigate the Arctic as the epicenter of global warming and to gain fundamental knowledge to better understand global climate change. Hundreds of researchers from 20 countries are involved in this exceptional endeavour. The MOSAiC expedition will bring RV POLARSTERN close to the North Pole for a full year. The data gathered will be used by scientists around the globe to take climate research to a completely new level. MOSAiC is spearheaded by the Alfred Wegener Institute, Helmholtz Centre for Polar and Marine Research (AWI).
